## Welcome to Alert Level 2 - from Monday 31 August

Yesterday, the Prime Minister advised that we are moving to Alert Level 2 at the end of this week and schools are safe environments for children and staff and that additional public health control measures are in place to prevent the spread of disease and to support contact tracing.

The good news is that from next **Monday (31 August)**, we will be welcoming all students and staff back to our school site.

Our school will be open from 8.55am on Monday 31 August for all students.

Our school day finishes at 3pm.

Under Alert Level 2, we advise any students and staff to stay at home if they are sick.

Physical distancing is a good precaution to help prevent the spread of disease. We do however know it is challenging in schools, so good hygiene practices and regular cleaning are even more important. This includes coughing into their elbows, handwashing and regular cleaning of commonly touched surfaces.

## Key messages

- If your child is unwell they must stay home
- Our school is open for all students from Monday 31 August
- Parents/Caregivers can drop children at school from 8.30am
- We ask that only staff and students are to enter the classrooms
- Your child will need to bring a drink bottle of water and food for morning tea and lunch
- After school care will resume under Level 2 from Monday. This is open only to the children who are currently registered in the After School care Programme.
- There will not be any whole school assemblies
- All students and staff will follow safe distancing guidelines. Under Alert Level 2 this is maintaining a physical distance so that they are not breathing on or touching each other.
- We will be giving the classrooms and toilets a thorough clean each day
